### Reliance on the Solar Provider Statement

The applicant will rely on this Solar Provider Statement to qualify for a rebate. Sustainability Victoria reserves the right to contact other government agencies and third parties to verify the information contained in the Solar Provider Statement. If you provide false or misleading information, we may refuse to accept any further Solar Provider Statements from you, report you to the Clean Energy Council or take such other action as we consider reasonable.
