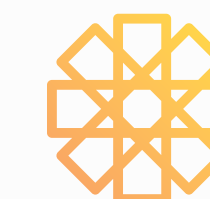

The Solar for Apartments Program offers rebates to install solar (PV) systems on multi-dwelling developments such as apartments, units and townhouses. .

Rebates of up to \$2,800 per apartment, with a maximum amount of \$140,000 for buildings of up to 50 lots, are available.

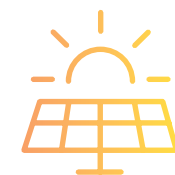

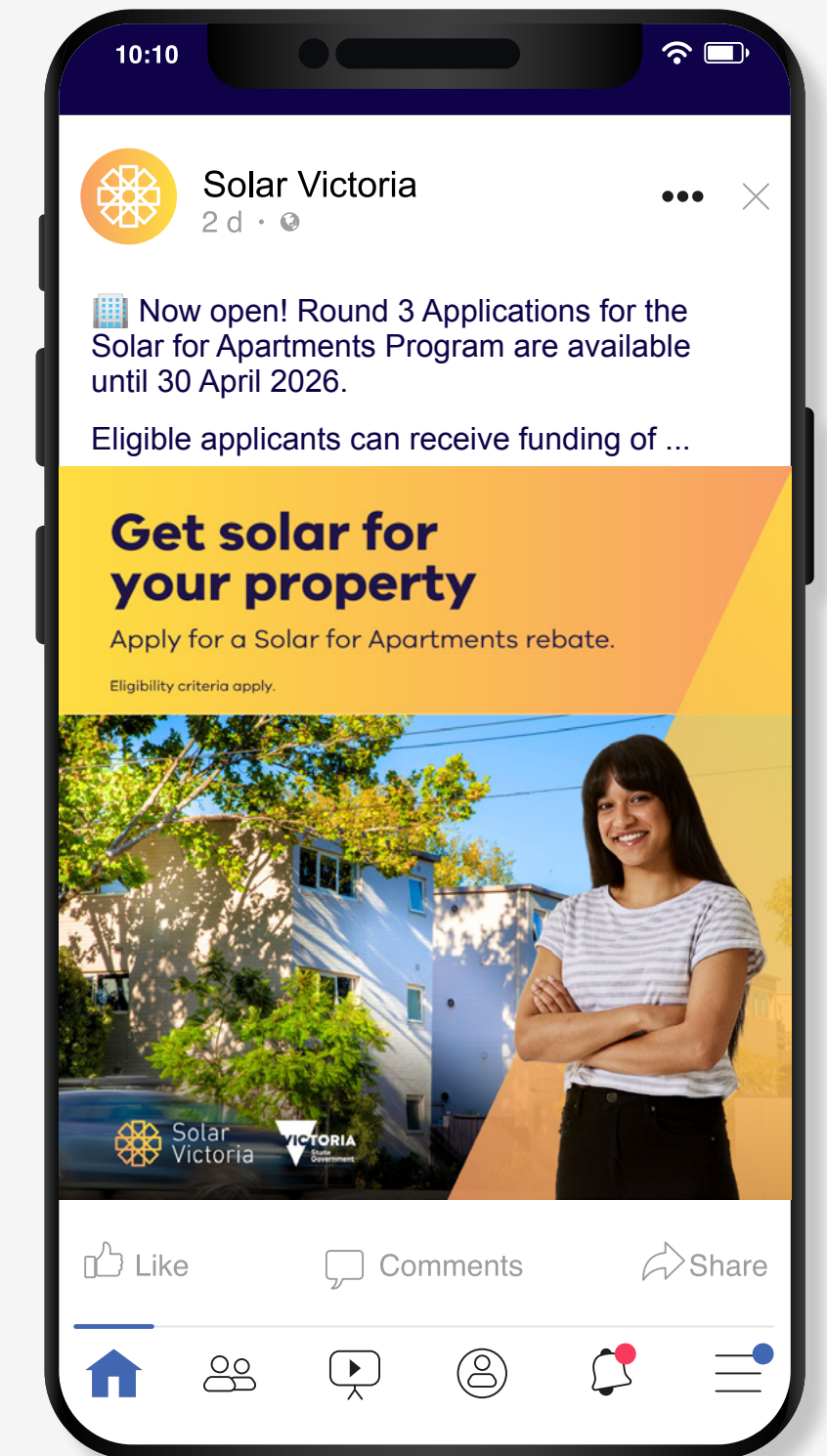

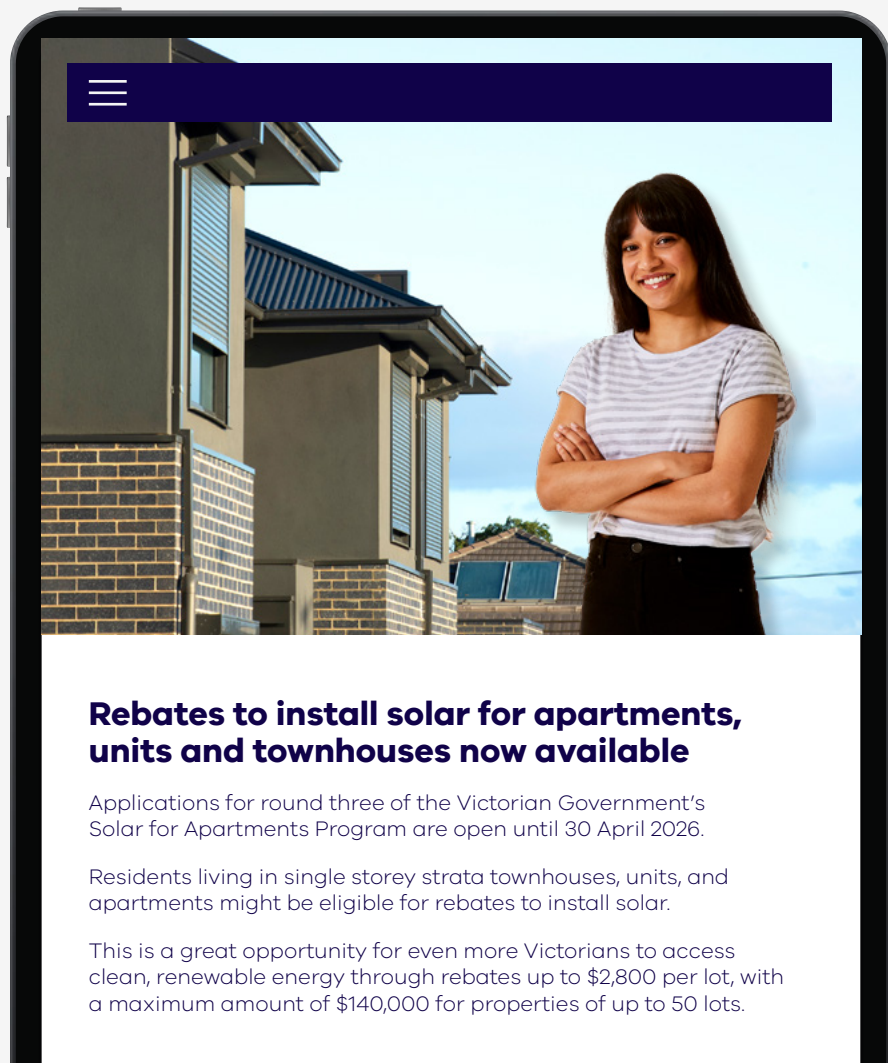
Eligible applicants can receive funding of up to \$140,000 for solar PV installation on multi-dwelling properties, for up to 50 lots (\$2,800 per household).

Rebates to install solar for apartments, units and townhouses now available

Applications for round three of the Victorian Government's Solar for Apartments Program are open until 30 April 2026.

Residents living in single storey strata townhouses, units, and apartments might be eligible for rebates to install solar.

This is a great opportunity for even more Victorians to access clean, renewable energy through rebates up to \$2,800 per lot, with a maximum amount of \$140,000 for properties of up to 50 lots.

The Solar for Apartments Program is jointly funded by the Victorian and Commonwealth governments. It will help to remove existing barriers for installing solar on multi-lot developments and enable retailers to provide apartment residents with safe and effective solar technologies.

Going solar now easier for apartments, units and townhouses

The Victorian Government is helping more Victorians benefit from solar by supporting residents living in apartments, units and townhouses.

Applications are open for Victorians living in eligible apartment buildings, strata townhouses and units under the control of an Owners Corporation and sharing a common property rooftop until 30 April 2026.

Rebates of up to \$2,800 per lot, with a maximum amount of \$140,000 for properties of up to 50 lots are on offer. The program is jointly funded by the Victorian and Commonwealth governments and is delivered by Solar Victoria.

To reduce the upfront costs, rebates are paid directly to the retailer and deducted from the final invoice. Owners corporations will pay any outstanding balance to the retailer.

Eligible properties include apartment buildings up to 8 storeys in height and single storey townhouses and units. They must be under the control of an Owners Corporation and share a common property rooftop. By adopting solar, an average household in a multi-unit development can save up to \$500 a year on their electricity bills.

1. Visit the Solar Victoria website and check if you're eligible.
2. Have a conversation with other residents and your Owners Corporation (OC) or Strata Manager about applying.
3. After you have support from your OC to go ahead, visit our website to begin your application.
